Notice of Tax Revenue Increase

The Harris County Emergency Services District No. 48 conducted public hearings on October 4, 2017 AND October 16, 2017 on a proposal to increase the total tax revenues of the Harris County Emergency Services District No. 48 from properties on the tax roll in the preceding year by 9.61 percent.

The total tax revenue proposed to be raised last year at last year's tax rate of \$.10000 for each \$100 of taxable value was \$10,074,413.

The total tax revenue proposed to be raised this year at the proposed tax rate of \$.10000 for each \$100 of taxable value, excluding tax revenue to be raised from new property added to the tax roll this year, is \$11,196,978.

The total tax revenue proposed to be raised this year at the proposed tax rate of \$.10000 for each \$100 of taxable value, including tax revenue to be raised from new property added to the tax roll this year, is \$11,592,372.

The Board of Emergency Services Commissioners of Harris County Emergency Services District No. 48 is scheduled to vote on the tax rate that will result in that tax increase at a public meeting to be held on October 19, 2017 at 7:00 PM at 21201 Morton Road, Katy, Texas 77449.

The Commissioners of Harris County Emergency Services District No. 48 propose to use the increase in total tax revenue for the purpose of providing adequate personnel, stations and equipment to keep pace with growth in the District.
